

Inauguration of Pakistan Sub-Center of China South Asia Technology Center at PCSIR, Islamabad

The Federal Minister for Science & Technology, Rana Tanveer Hussain and Vice Premier/ Minister for Science & Technology, People's Republic of China, Mr. Wang Yang jointly inaugurated Pakistan Sub-Center of China South Asia Technology Transfer Center (CSTTC) on July 8, 2017 at PCSIR, Islamabad.

The main purpose for the establishment of CSTTC-Sub Center Pakistan is to provide a strong platform for transfer of technology to the local industry. The CSTTC would also facilitate Chinese assistance in mega infrastructure projects that include Energy, Technology and Road Networks through Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) or Public-Private-Partnership.

Moreover, China would enhance collaboration with Pakistan in the fields of telecommunications, agriculture, trade, railways, industry and infrastructure building. Joint Research labs would be established for providing training to the scientists of South Asia and South East Asian countries.



It is hoped that CSTTC would not only promote the research and development activities at PCSIR and its commercial partners but it would also strengthen the local industry of Pakistan to boost the country's economy.

PSQCA Team Seals Factories Manufacturing Substandard Products

A team from PSQCA raided Oil and Ghee Mills at Korangi Industrial Area, Karachi. The team caught sub-standard unlicensed Ghee & Cooking Oil from M/s Chamba International Oil Mills i.e. Chand Sooraj Banaspati, Dara-e-Khaiber Banaspati, GoGo Banaspati, Shere-Punjab Banaspati. The factory was using Pakistan Standards Mark on the packing of Ghee/ Cooking oil without having license form PSQCA. The team seized the products on spot and sealed the factory. PSQCA has warned producers and manufacturers to manufacture products according to Pakistan Standards specifications and display



the Pakistan Standards Mark on their products after receiving valid license from the Authority failing which the Authority will take action under the rules.



PSQCA also seized a unit of M/s. Golden Lubricants also working as Sharjah Lubes International Engine Lubricating at Site Karachi. The unit was found involved in illegal production and sale of lubricant Engine oil. As per Act of PSQCA, it is mandatory to get license from PSQCA for production of lubricant oil.
